The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

Explain how this is an "unforeseen" threat pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.1.

In general, there is a conflict between Paragraph (a) and (c). Paragraph (a) stated that the Rule is applicable to certain areas while Paragraph (c), which is part of The Rule, states that it is applicable to all marked swimming areas on Lake Norman. Which is it?

Line 15: Is "vessel" defined in your rules? Does the agency intend the same definition as G.S. 75A-2(5)?

Line 15: Define "no wake speed".

Lines 19-20: Cite the statute concerning designation.

Line 21: Define "vessel liveries".

Lines 29-30: As written, there is an ambiguity. The documentation is to be made available at the request of the livery company? Consider: "Both parties shall sign and date documentation verifying adherence to these requirements on the date the rental begins. The vessel livery shall maintain a copy of this documentation for a period of two years from the date of rental which shall be made available to law enforcement officers upon request. The vessel renter shall have a copy of the documentation on the vessel and available for law enforcement upon demand during the term of the rental."

Despite the ability of the Lake Norman Marine Commission to establish regulations concerning public recreation and water safety, enforcement of those regulations without joint resolution, as required by S.L.1969-1089, or regulations codified in Rule, has been difficult, leading to lack of action against liveries and increased safety concerns among lake users.
