- 4 (a) No student shall be given credit for more than eight total hours during any instruction day.
- 5 (b) Students shall record their start time by electronic means upon entering the school for practical or theory hours.
- 6 Students shall not record any period of break from instruction, even if remaining on school premises.
- 7 (c) In meeting the minimum course work and designated barber school curricula required by Rule .0120 of this
- 8 Section, no student shall be given credit for more than eight hours per month and 40 hours for the duration of
- 9 enrollment in the school that were obtained by instruction or demonstration off school premises or from a field trip.
