The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

Page 1, Line 19: Define "skin diving." Does skin diving include free diving? What about snorkeling? I am aware that G.S. 75A-13.1 uses the term. While the General Assembly can use ambiguous terms in legislation, pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.9(a)(2), agencies may not.

Page 1, Lines 19-20: Given G.S. 75A-13.1, explain why Paragraph (c) is necessary pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.9(a)(3).

Page 1, Line 22: Consider simply stating Subparagraph (a) of this Rule.

Page 1, Line 25: Explain the agency's authority to mandate a task by North Carolina State Parks.

Page 1, Line 25: Is it not the NC Division of Parks and Recreation that you are attempting to regulate?
