The waiver shall be in effect for any period that is disregarded under Section 7508 of the Internal Revenue Code in determining the taxpayer's 20 21 liability for a federal tax. (e) For the 2020 21, 2021 22, 2022 23, and 2023 24 licensure years only, the Board waives the in person course 22 requirements of Paragraph (a) of this Rule and licensees may take all of their CEUs for those licensure years 23 electronically.
