At its meeting on April 28, 2026, the Rules Review Commission (RRC) extended the period of review for the above captioned rules on the RRC's April agenda. Pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.13, when the Commission extends the period of review, it is required to approve or object to rules or call a public hearing on the same within 70 days; however, the RRC intends to review these rules at its June 2026 meeting.
