"natural, unobstructed and accessible path" is simply providing guidance as to how the travel distance shall be calculated. The plumbing code handles this well in access to plumbing fixtures so no additional clarification is required for this building code definition.

I italicized "toilet room" and "plumbing fixture" in the revised rule.

Title "15A" is added to the NCAC reference in the tables.

I'm the attorney who reviewed the Rules submitted by the BCC for the May 2023 RRC meeting.
