G.S. 20-166.1(j) states: "The Division may periodically publish statistical information on motor vehicle accidents based on information in accident reports." These rules are purely informational, restating the information contained in in the Division's statistical reports. Further, these rules do not affect the procedural or substantive rights of the public. As a result, staff recommends objection for lack of necessity because the contents of .0201, .0202, and .0203 do not meet the definition of a "rule" in 150B-2(8a).
