5 A final order imposing civil liability under Section 14(a) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act  
6 (FIFRA) (codified at [7 USC § 136l(a)] against any pesticide dealer, pesticide applicator, public operator, or pest  
7 control consultant, or a criminal [~~conviction,~~ conviction or entry of a plea of [~~guilty,~~ guilty] or of nolo contendere  
8 under Section 14(b) of FIFRA (7 USC 136l(b)) by any pesticide dealer, pesticide applicator, public operator, or pest  
9 control consultant shall constitute grounds for the denial, suspension, or revocation of any license or certification  
10 issued by the [~~board,~~ Board].
