Ashley,

The North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission (NCWRC) offers the following responses to the comments on temporary rule 15A NCAC 10D .0103, received by Ashley Snyder, Commission Counsel, on 10 June 2021 from Mr. Travis Narron.

**1. COMMENT:** They put out the public notice on 5-12-21 for the hearing on 5-13-21 that I was on and I pointed this out and on the morning on 5-18-21 the notice was gone from the site.

**NCWRC RESPONSE:** Notice of the 13 May 2021 NCWRC hearing for proposed temporary rule 15A NCAC 10D .0103 was sent to the interested persons email list (approximately 2,550 emails) and OAH on 23 April 2021 (Exhibit A). Mr. Narron is on the interested person email list (Exhibit B). The NCWRC verified that the notice of the hearing was sent to Mr. Narron's e-mail address (Exhibit C). The NCWRC was also able to verify that the notice sent to Mr. Narron's email address was opened on 23 April 2021 (Exhibit D).

Notice of the date and time of the hearing, along with detailed information regarding the proposed temporary rule, was posted to the NCWRC website on 23 April 2021 and remained on the website until the end of the public comment period, 21 May 2021 (Exhibit E).

Additionally, a press release (Exhibit F) was sent out on 4 May 2021 with detailed information, including the date and time of the hearing.

**2. COMMENT:** It states that the department has to notify all interested parties and of the 29 people I know that submitted letters for Legislative review have not been notified.

**NCWRC RESPONSE:** The NCWRC sent notice to its interested persons list on 23 April 2021. Mr. Narron is on the interested persons list and received the notice via email on 23 April 2021. The NCWRC typically notifies the head/lead of special interest groups as notice to interested parties. In this case, Mr. Narron appeared to be the organizer of the interested party that sent the objection letters. Additionally, Nathaniel Honaker, the attorney for the N.C. Sporting Dog Association, also received the notice from NCWRC on 23 April 2021.

As previously mentioned, a press release was also sent out about the proposed temporary rule and hearing.

Furthermore, the 13 May 2021 hearing was virtual, generally making attendance easier for constituents and the public. For this meeting, the NCWRC offered both a web option and a callin option.

**3. COMMENT:** Then on 6-4-21 Wildlife put out a notice for a Special Special Meeting on Chronic Wasting Disease and never said they would vote on the Temporary Rule.

**NCWRC RESPONSE:** Notice of the 9 June 2021 NCWRC commission meeting was provided.

**4. COMMENT:** On the first online comment the vote was 224 Against and 109 For the rule. They didn't put out the number for the comments for 5-13-21 meeting but there was 6 comments against and none for.

**NCWRC RESPONSE:** The NCWRC is not aware of a requirement to provide the number of comments submitted broken down by "for" or "against" a rule. All public comments received for 15A NCAC 10D .0103 were provided to the Commission, presented in an exhibit, and considered by the NCWRC.

**5. COMMENT:** On the meeting agenda page 14 at the bottom it said One public hearing was held May 19 2021 where 24 people in attendance that is not correct it was on 5-13-21.

**NCWRC RESPONSE:** The agenda for the 9 June 2021 NCWRC commission meeting stated that the public hearing for 15A NCAC 10D .0103 was held on 19 May 2021. This date was a typo and it should have reflected a hearing date of 13 May 2021. The typo on this exhibit did not affect any rulemaking requirement. The correct hearing date was submitted to OAH when the rule was filed.

#### 15A NCAC 10D .0103 Hunting on Game Lands - Temporary Rule

Module Expired - 5/21/2021 11:59:00 PM

Temporary amendments to this rule are necessary to establish hunting seasons and manage game lands. This rule was adopted by the Agency in February 2021 and was objected to. At this point, permanent rulemaking is contrary to public interest, as changes need to be in place before August 1, 2021 when the public is notified of upcoming 2021-2022 hunting seasons. To avoid confusing the regulated public, the agency is adopting this rule under temporary procedures.

The following changes are proposed to establish hunting seasons and manage game lands:

- · Correct the name of Alcoa game land to Yadkin River game land.
- Clarify December segment of the bear season for Alligator River, Buckridge, Chowan Swamp, Gull Rock, and Van Swamp game lands.
- · Correct the primitive weapons seasons for deer on Nicholson Creek Game Land.
- Change Perkins Game Land from an Introductory Either-Sex Gun Season to a Conservative Either-Sex Gun Season.
- Add definitions of "Seven Days per Week Game Land" and "Four Days per Week Game Land"
- Change six game lands to "Four Days per Week Game Lands" and 45 game lands to "Seven Days per Week Game Lands".
- · Prohibit the harvest of bear on Sunday on 25 game lands in the Coastal Bear Management Unit
- · Remove Brunswick County Game Land from the program.
- Clarify when and where horseback riding is allowed on R. Wayne Bailey-Caswell, Chatham, Jordan, Pee Dee River, and Sandhills game lands.
- Prohibit the pursuing or chasing of deer and bear with dogs for the purposes of training or hunting on the Beaufort County portion of Goose Creek Game Land that is north of NC 33 except for that portion east of Smith Creek and south of Campbell Creek.
- · Remove references to impoundments on Stones Creek Game Land.
- · Clarify restrictions on Wildlife Conservation Areas.

# Wildlife Commission Notices Temporary Rule for Game Lands

**RALEIGH, N.C.** (May 4, 2021) – During its business meeting on April 22, the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission voted to notice a temporary rule for the 2021-22 hunting season. The rule, outlined below, was adopted by the Wildlife Commission in February but received objections.

By law, this rule is subject to legislative review, which will not be completed before the 2021-22 hunting season regulations are published on Aug. 1. Enacting a temporary rule will help avoid public confusion when the season starts.

Proposed temporary amendments to Rule <u>15A NCAC 10D .0103</u> include all previously adopted changes, with the exception of the prohibition of horseback riding on William H. Silvers Game Land and the name change of Alcoa Game Land To Yadkin River Game Land.

An online public hearing will be held on May 13 at 6 p.m. Pre-registration is required. The public can register online at <a href="https://www.ncwildlife.org/proposed-regulations">www.ncwildlife.org/proposed-regulations</a>.
