The general certification pursuant to Rule .0404 of this Section, or grandfather certification as defined in G.S. 17E-7(a), of a detention officer or a telecommunicator is eligible for lateral transfer to an agency and be certified, provided that the employing agency has complied with Paragraphs (b) and (c) of this Rule.

Line 17: Would not "was" be better "has been?"

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

Generally, to the Rule: The first sentence of this rule states that it shall be used to evaluate whether an applicant is eligible for a waiver of "the Commission-certified law enforcement training course" in 12 NCAC 10B .0504. However, Paragraph (4) sets forth two options to obtain eligibility; one of which is completion of the BLET plus probation. Is this not the same training for which the applicant seeks a waiver?

The other option is to complete the BLET and pass the examination set forth in 12 NCAC 09B.0406 plus meet the qualifications of Subparagraphs (ii)-(iv). Again, is the BLET not the training course for which a waiver is sought?

Page 1, Lines 7 and 16, Page 2, Lines 1 20: For future consideration, consider defining "Basic Law Enforcement Training Course" in the definition rule as any course meeting the standards of 12 NCAC 09B .0205 and accredited pursuant to rule ______ of the Subsection.

Page 1, Line 35: Add "any" before "training and experience" or define the "training" and "experience" qualifiers.

Page 2, Line 13: Define "North Carolina applicants." Is it any applicant without regard to prior employment or status who is from North Carolina?

Page 3, Line 1: Authorized by whom?

Page 3, Line 5: What criteria or standard will be applied to determine the instructor's satisfaction?

Page 3, Lines 12-16: The list cannot be formatted in this way. Please see 26 NCAC 02C .0206.

Page 4, Line 2: "Peace officer's standards and training" should not be capitalized.
