21 NCAC 25 .0701 is amended as published in NC register 39:20 as follows

SECTION .0700 – SANCTIONS

21 NCAC 25 .0701 SCHEDULE OF PENALTIES AND PUBLICATION OF DISCIPLINE

(a). The presumptive penalty for any violation of any provision of Chapter 90D of the North Carolina General Statutes or any rule adopted by the Board shall be:

- (1) ~~\$100~~ \$500 for the first violation; and
- (2) ~~\$200~~ \$1,000 ~~for the second violation~~ subsequent violations;
- (3) ~~\$400 for the third violation; and~~
- (4) ~~\$800 for the fourth violation~~

(b). After issuance of a final order determining any person violated Chapter 90D of the North Carolina General Statutes or any rule adopted by the Board, the Board shall publish to its website the person's name, violation type, date of violation, and the assessed penalty for each violation.
