In (e), p.2, lines 12-13, is "advanced dental education program" defined anywhere? I saw in the answer to the pre-review, that this language is contained in G.S. 90-36(b1)(2), but I wonder if the Board has metrics for determining what is and what is not considered an "advance dental education program."

In (g), line 24, I noted from your pre-review answers that "fraud or by any false representation" is a finding made by the Board pursuant to a disciplinary process. I think it might be good to say that explicitly here.

5	to the Board:
6	(1) a notarized application form provided by the Board at www.ncdentalboard.org that includes
7	information and materials required by Rule .0301(a) of this Subchapter;
8	(2) a letter of recommendation from the applicant's employing dental school or academic medical
9	center; and
10	(3) the non-refundable licensure by credentials fee set forth in 21 NCAC 16M .0101.
11	(b) An application shall be complete when the Board receives all information and documentation required by this
12	Rule. Partial applications that are not completed within one year of the date the first document is submitted to the
13	Board shall be disregarded as expired without a refund of the application fee.
14	(c) Any applicant who changes his or her address shall notify the Board office in writing within 10 business days.
15	(d) Any license obtained through fraud or by any false representation shall be revoked.
