The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

Page 2, Line 6: Add a comma after "if any".

Page 2, Paragraph (c): There are subject-verb agreement issues. i.e. "individuals that (3) is an applicant..."

Page 2, Line 30: What kind of waiver?

Page 2, Line 33: Add "have" prior to "completed".

Page 3, Line 16: I do not believe that the semicolon is proper. It should be a comma.

Page 3, Lines 28-37 and Page 4, Lines 1-27, Parts (A) and (B): These are formatted incorrectly. They should be indented further.

4 (a) Applicants for detention officer certification with prior detention or correctional officer experience who have been 5 employed and certified as a detention or correctional officer may seek a training waiver evaluation pursuant to this

6 Section.

7 (b) The Division shall use the following to evaluate a detention officer's training and experience to grant a training8 waiver:

- 9 (1) Persons who separated from a detention officer position during the probationary period after 10 completion of a commission-certified Detention Officer Certification Course and who have been 11 separated from a detention officer position for more than one year shall complete a subsequent 12 commission-certified Detention Officer Certification Course in its entirety and pass the State 13 Comprehensive Examination within the 12 month probationary period as set forth in Rule .0602(a) 14 of this Section.
- 15 (2) Persons who separated from a detention officer position during their probationary period after 16 completion of a commission-certified Detention Officer Certification Course and who have been 17 separated from a detention officer position for one year or less shall serve the remainder of the initial 18 probationary period in accordance with G.S. 17E-7(b), but need not complete an additional training 19 program.
- (3) Persons who separated from a detention officer position during the probationary period without
   completion of a commission-certified Detention Officer Certification Course, or whose certification
   was suspended pursuant to Rule .0204(b)(1) of this Subchapter and who have remained separated
   or suspended for over one year shall complete a commission-certified Detention Officer
   Certification Course in its entirety and pass the State Comprehensive Examination, and shall be
   allowed a 12 month probationary period as prescribed in Rule .0602(a) of this Section.

1 Detention officers that are granted a training waiver under this section shall serve a 12-month probationary 2 period as set forth in Rule .0602(a) of this Section and provide the record of completion of the Basic 3 Correctional Officer Training Course as defined in 12 NCAC 09G .0411. The Division shall review the 4 course curriculum of the correctional officer training received against the training required by Rule .0601 of 5 this Section and determine whether that training is comparable to the requirements set out in Rule .0601 of this Section. Based upon topics covered in the basic correctional officer training course, and the Division 6 7 shall determine if additional training is required to ensure the applicant has received training comparable to 8 that specified in Rule .0601 of this Section. The Division shall notify the employing agency of the resulting 9 training requirements, if any, and the officer shall take and successfully complete the State Comprehensive 10 Examination as set forth in 12 NCAC 10B .0606 Rule .0606 of this Section in its entirety during the 11 probationary period after completing any training as determined to be necessary by the training evaluation 12 referenced in this section, in a commission-certified Detention Officer Certification Course.
