13	less than weekly for a period of not less than ninety days. Proof of the giving of such notice shall be retained by the					
14	licensee.					
15	(d) (c) Any licensee ceasing practice shall maintain control and custody of the records located at that practice location					
16	until such time as such records are transferred to the patients or to the custody of another practitioner similarly licensed					
17	(d) Should an optometrist pass away while in practice, the optometrist's estate shall comply with paragraph (b) above					
18	and attempt to place any medical records for which no directions are received from the patient into the hands of an					
19	optometrist or ophthalmologist located in proximity to the deceased optometrist's practice location as soon as possible.					
20	Any records retained by the estate shall be maintained for the period of time required by 21 NCAC 42E .0102 (6).
