Line 8: The agency is requiring an affidavit and statement of affirmation?

Line 11-12: This is unclear. If a recipient has designated four counties, but his/her practice per county is less than 30%, do they qualify? Is the measure per county? Or cumulative? I.E. If 10% of my practice in Wake is large animal, 10% in Durham, 5% in Harnett, and 6% in Lee, do I qualify? Or is it 30% of my practice as a whole?

Line 13: Change "must" to "shall."

Line 16: See comments from Lines 7-8.

Lines 18-19: See comments for Lines 11-12.

Line 23: Change "must" to "shall."

Lines 25-27: Ought this not be a new Paragraph?
