The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of these Rules prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed these Rules and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether these Rules will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing these Rules, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

18 NCAC 07G .0107: As written, this rule is unclear in two ways.

- 1) Is a vendor required to make and keep a copy of a certificate from an in-person certificate pursuant to 7G .0106? Reading .0106 and .0107 together I do not know the answer.
- 2) As a separate rule, I don't think the phrase "the commission certificate" is sufficiently clear as to what certificate this is referring to. I can imagine two ways to solve this: either merging this requirement into rule .0106 so that it is clear within the rule what certificate is being kept. Alternatively, you could reference rule .0106 in this rule (i.e. "the commission certificate received pursuant to 18 NCAC 07G .0106(2)", assuming that is what you meant.

I believe solving one of these problems will solve both, so I provided examples just to make sure my concern is clear.
