The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

In (c), line 11, who may purchase adult day care services? The sentence is written in the passive tense. Please revise in the active tense and specify who makes the purchase.

Same for (c), lines 12-13. Revise from the passive to the active tense and specify who may make the purchase.

In (d), lines 17-18, would only the county department of social services make the reimbursement? SL 2023-65 changes G.S. 143B-153(2a) to say that the county DSS or a designee of the board of county commissioners may set the reimbursement rate, but I'm not sure that means either body can actually make the reimbursement itself.

In your History Note, there's no need to cite to SL 2021-180, as that language has been codified into 143B-153(2a), unless you're citing to Section 9A.3B.(c) of the session law.

12	following a pre	admission assessment as specified in 10A NCAC 06R .0501. Adult day health services may only be
13	purchased for an individual following a preadmission health assessment as specified in 10A NCAC 06S .0204(c)(2)(A)	
14	and a determination that the individual needs one or more services as set forth in 10A NCAC 06S .0402(a).	
15	(d) The maximum reimbursement rate for transporting an adult day care client to an adult day care program not exceed	
16	one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) for a one-way trip. If an adult day care or adult day health provider elects to provide	
17	or arrange for transportation services for the individual who attends the program, the county department of social	
18	services may reimburse the adult day care or adult day health provider for transporting the individual to the adult day	
19	care or adult day health program.
