Re: Periodic Rule Review Readoption Schedule

Dear Travis:

Thank you for your tremendous assistance in navigating the new periodic rule review process for the Board of Pharmacy. At today's meeting of the Board, after reviewing its rulemaking schedule, the Board agreed to propose a readoption deadline of May 1, 2031, which was one of your suggested dates.

This deadline will accommodate the Board's active rulemaking schedule. As you know, our Board continually reviews and revises its rules. I count about four dozen rules that the Board has adopted, amended, or repealed over the previous period similar in length to the one proposed as a deadline here, and I expect at least a similar volume of normal rulemaking activity before this deadline. The Board, its staff and its working groups are currently engaged in, or planning, reviews of rules contained in seven sections of the chapter. This will continue to occupy much of the Board's time in the coming years. Much of the Board's rulemaking is done through working groups that include industry participants with varied backgrounds and perspectives, which leads to the best rulemaking results but takes significant time.

However, to the extent that it can be done as part of the normal rulemaking, the Board plans to readopt any sections affected at the same time as the normal rulemaking involving those sections. This will spread both the Board's and the Commission's readoption work over time instead of having all the readoption hit at the same time. It further will allow those sections to be reviewed organically when other changes are being made, allowing the Board to consider those sections in the context where both the Board and the regulated public are already focused on the particular subject matter of those sections.

The Board provides this estimated schedule for readoption of the rules:

November 2026 to September 2028	• Readopt any sections that can be readopted as part of normal rulemaking.
September 2028 to May 2029	• Identify which additional rules will require substantive changes and which can be readopted without substantive changes. • Consult with the OSBM regarding development and approval of the fiscal note, if one is required.
May 2029 to May 2030	• Submit draft rules to RRC counsel for pre-review, if substantive changes are contemplated. • Propose readoption, and submit notice of text. • Provide notice to the public and interested persons regarding proposed readoption. • Hold public hearing and accept and review public comments.
May 2030 to May 1, 2031	• Adoption by the Board. • Allow time for republication, if needed. • Submit to RRC within 30 days of adoption.

Please let me know if you have any questions or suggestions about this schedule. We look forward to working with you and your colleagues on our readoptions.
