6 The Agronomic Services Division shall analyze all samples for volume weight, pH, BpH, humic matter, phosphorus,
7 potassium, calcium, magnesium, manganese, copper and zinc. The Agronomic Services Division shall make nutrient
8 and management recommendations to correct deficiencies or toxicities by the application of lime, fertilizer, and
9 other soil amendments.

10 (a) The Agronomic Services Division shall analyze all samples for volume weight, pH, BpH, humic matter,
11 phosphorus, potassium, calcium, magnesium, manganese, [copper]copper, and zinc. The Agronomic Services
12 Division shall make nutrient and management recommendations to correct deficiencies or toxicities by the

3 **02 NCAC 37 .0202 PLANT ANALYSIS SERVICE**

4 (a) The Agronomic Services Division shall analyze all samples for nitrogen, phosphorus, potassium, calcium,
5 magnesium, manganese, copper, zinc, ~~boron~~boron, and other elements, as needed to make recommendations for
6 corrective action. Results of the test and recommendations for corrective action shall be provided by the Agronomic
7 Services Division. For the purposes of this Rule, "plant analyses" shall include analysis of wastes, soilless media,
8 and other solutions for agronomic purposes.

9 (b) Fees for these services, to be paid at the time of submission, shall be as follows:

10 (1) Routine plant analysis - ~~\$5.00.~~\$10.00.

11 (2) Routine solution analysis - ~~\$5.00.~~\$10.00.

12 (3) Routine soilless media analysis - ~~\$5.00.~~\$10.00.

13 (4) Routine waste analysis - ~~\$8.00.~~\$15.00.

4 (a) Individuals desiring nematode analysis may obtain sample containers and instructions from the Agronomic
5 Services Division, county extension office, farm supply dealers, Agronomic Division Regional Agronomists, or other
6 local agricultural advisors. If plant-destructive nematodes are found, the best method of control will be recommended.

7 (b) Per sample fees for those services, to be paid at the time of submission, are as follows:
