My team of election integrity advocates has offered important modifications for the following rules to NCSBE, but the NCSBE failed to incorporate those recommendations in their submission to the

RRC. Please allow me to cite why these rules should be deleted or modified because they lack clarity, statutory authority, necessity, or compliance with the APA:

08 NCAC 10C .0101 (DEFINITIONS)

08 NCAC 10C .0103 (ELECTIONEERING ZONE)

08 NCAC 10C .0104 (CONDUCT AT VOTING SITES)

08 NCAC 18 .0503 (NON-CURABLE DEFICIENCIES)

08 NCAC 18 .0504 (IRREGULARITIES THAT DO NOT REQUIRE FURTHER ACTION FROM THE VOTER)

08 NCAC 18 .0505 (IRREGULARITIES THAT REQUIRE FURTHER ACTION)
