Pursuant to 26 NCAC 05 .0105 it is ultimately up to the chair how to address requests to speak, but it is usually not a problem to participate via webex or in person at the speakers preference. I will be speaking to the chair tomorrow and will let you know if anything comes up.

There are two requirements under that rule which I'm not sure you've met. One is to notify the rulemaking coordinator of the rule in question, which I am remedying by cc'ing them on this email.
