The school must provide (supply) the equipment in the list for student use, but the Board doesn't establish the method or transaction between the student and the school for permanent ownership of the equipment.
- I've updated the formatting for margins and line spacing. I used 21 NCAC 02C .0108 as a checklist but I don't see another issue with formatting. Is there a specific issue you can point out?
- 88B-17 doesn't appear to be relevant to these rules, I'm not sure why it is in the history note for all three. I removed the reference in each rule.
