The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

In (a), line 4, is "local confinement facility" defined?

Yes. This is defined at 15A NCAC 18A.1501(1).

In (a), line 4, is there a particular section of 15A NCAC 18C that the facility needs to comply with? That's a large subchapter.

This is intended to capture a connection to a compliant public water supply (set out on under subchapter 18C).

In (b), line 6, the statutory term used in 130A-313(10) is "non-community water <u>system</u>" not "supply".

We made this change.

In (b), line 9, I think the reference to 10A NCAC 41C .0102 is incorrect. That rule governs the activities of the Occupational Health Section and does not mention laboratory certification.

We have corrected this to 10A NCAC 42C .0102.

In (d), I think you could combine the sentences and make them a bit clearer: "Local confinement facilities shall provide water heating facilities, and shall provide hot and cold running water under pressure to carry out all operations."

We made this change.

In (d), line 16-17, what do you mean by "all operations"? I suppose it's probably obvious, but what is the intent here?

This is intended to be comprehensive of all operations that require water, including cleaning, food preparation, and hygiene.
