Page 1, Line 21, Paragraph (c): Explain why the Director's determination of eligibility is not contrary to G.S. 150B-10 in which the Commission decides eligibility over \$12.5K or in matters involving future economic loss.

Please see NCGS 15B-10. After further review NCGS 15B-10 addresses eligibility for awarding claims. Therefore, this rule is not necessary and duplicative of the statute. Therefore, we are deleting it from the rule.

Page 1, Lines 21-22, Paragraph (c): Who makes the decision whether a claimant has cooperated?

After further review, this language is duplicative of 15B-11(c). Therefore, we are deleting it from the rule. Please see edit lines 21-22.

Page 1, Line 22, Paragraph (c): Replace "may" with "shall" or explain the criteria which will be used in exercising this discretion.

After further review, this language is duplicative of 15B-11(c). Therefore, we are deleting it from the rule. Please see edit line 22.

Page 1, Line 23, Paragraph (c): Investigated by whom? Please see edit line 23. Each claim is investigated by Commission staff.

Page 1, Line 25, Paragraph (d): The use of the word "may" implies discretion. What criteria will be considered in exercising this discretion? Please see edit in line 25. After further review, this language is not consistent with NCGS 15B-11(d). Therefore, we are deleting it from the rule.

Page 1, Line 27-28, Paragraph (d): I believe you mean G.S. 15B-11(d). Please see edit lines 27-28. This is correct. However, as described above we are deleting this sentence.
