Explain: S.L. 2023-134, Sections 8A.6.(k)–(r), required the SBE to establish a set of graduation requirements that allow students enrolled in North Carolina public high schools to graduate within 3 years of enrollment in 9th Grade. Sections 8A.6.(k) also amended G.S. 115C-12(9d) to prohibit local boards of education from establishing additional requirements beyond those established by the State Board. Section 8A.6.(s) directed the SBE to adopt an emergency rule to implement these requirements. The emergency rule became effective on November 16, 2023, and the temporary rule became effective on February 8, 2024. The SBE has now adopted a permanent rule, which does not differ in any substantive way from the temporary rule.
