The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

In (e), p.2, lines 12-13, is "advanced dental education program" defined anywhere? I saw in the answer to the pre-review, that this language is contained in G.S. 90-36(b1)(2), but I wonder if the Board has metrics for determining what is and what is not considered an "advance dental education program." As noted in the pre-review answer, "advanced dental education program" is a category of programs accredited by the American Dental Association's Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA). What is or is not considered an "advanced dental education program" is determined by CODA. The Board does not make the determination.

In (g), line 24, I noted from your pre-review answers that "fraud or by any false representation" is a finding made by the Board pursuant to a disciplinary process. I think it might be good to say that explicitly here. The History Note cites G.S. 90-41, which governs disciplinary action. This phrasing is currently in nineteen Board rules for obtaining licenses and permits. It is clear and unambiguous, and has been approved by the Rules Review Commission in 2020, 2021, and as recently as June 15, 2023, for 21 NCAC 16C .0501(f). The Board's regulated public understands that revocation of a license is a measure taken pursuant to disciplinary process. Modifying the phrase in this rule would create confusion among the Board's regulated public because it would create the appearance that this rule means something different than all the other rules with this phrasing.
