If required 27 information is identified as missing during the Pre-Application Review Meeting, an extension may 28 be granted for up to three business days to submit the required information, after which time a 29 determination regarding the Request for Express Review shall be made. If these identified items 30 are not submitted by the extension deadline, the Request for Express Review shall be considered 31 incomplete and shall be denied.
- 32 (5) If the Request for Express Review is granted, the next available Acceptance Date shall be assigned
  33 to the Application and the application review shall proceed in accordance with Rule .0203 or

In (5), line 11, "Vicinity map identifying the project area, GPS coordinates, and any nearby surface waters" can't be incorporated by reference under 150B-21.6. The specific surface waters identified in the cited rules may be incorporated by reference but please insert where the rules can be found and at what cost.

Agency Response: The rule incorporation is intended to incorporate the Class SA waters, Outstanding Resource Waters, High Quality Waters and Trout Waters identified in 15A NCAC 02B .0202, .0221, .0224, and .0225 not a map. The sentence has been slightly reworded for additional clarity. 15A

NCAC 02B .0225 was accidentally omitted from the incorporation and has been added. I'm satisfied with your rewording. Please "specify in the rule both where copies of the material can be obtained and the cost on the date the date the rule is adopted of a copy of the material". If the material can be accessed for free online, then provide a URL in the text of the rule, and state "may be accessed at [URL] at no charge."

I read the Style Guide to require incorporating rules under the authority of another agency (not DEQ) but doesn't require incorporation for another Commission within the same agency. Please remove the incorporation language in (4), (8), (9), (11), and (12).

Agency Response: As per GS 150B-21.6(2), the 02H rules proposed for incorporation by reference were adopted by the Environmental Management Commission (EMC). Pursuant to GS 143B-14, 143B-282(a) and 150B-2(1b), the EMC is a separate agency with separate rulemaking authority from DEQ, not a Commission within DEQ. In SL 2023-134, the General Assembly specified that these new rules are to be adopted by the Department, not the EMC.

#### 15A NCAC 01X .0301

In (2) and (4), why is it necessary to incorporate by reference each of the cited rules?

Agency Response: As per Chapter 11 of the OAH Style Guide, the Agency was incorporating rules under the authority of another Commission the first time that said rules were cited in Chapter 01X. If this is not necessary, the Agency can remove the incorporation from the rule. I read the Style Guide to require incorporating rules under the authority of another agency (not DEQ) but doesn't require incorporation for another Commission within the same agency. Please remove the incorporation language in (2) and (4).

Agency Response: As per GS 150B-21.6(2), the 04B rules proposed for incorporation by reference were adopted by the Sedimentation Control Commission (SCC). Pursuant to GS 143B-14, 143B-298 and 150B-2(1b), the SCC is a separate agency with separate rulemaking authority from DEQ, not a Commission within DEQ. In SL 2023-134, the General Assembly specified that these new rules are to be adopted by the Department, not the SCC.

On line 22, "15A NCAC 07" does not appear to exist in the NCAC. Please clarify. Agency Response: Chapter 07 of Title 15A contains the Coastal Management rules and can be viewed at <u>OAH - NCAC > Title 15A - Environmental Quality > Chapter 07 - Coastal Management - Browsing</u>. In (6), replace the second ".1000" with "02H." Also, replace "15A NCAC 07" with "the rules of Title 15A of Chapter 07" if that's what you intend to cite.
