Hello Brian,

We believe we've addressed the formatting issues in these attached versions of the 14E rules.

With regard to Rule .0109, thank you for noting that as it made us reconsider our approach. The website link was to the Enterprise system which is a platform developed for clinics and facilities regulated by the Division of Health Services Regulation (DHSR) to complete their licensure activities and registry verifications online. It requires that the clinics register with Enterprise and then they are given a portal through which those activities, including licensure renewal, can be completed. In other words, the renewal application is in the portal for the clinics to access, as opposed to a free standing, more specific link. In full candor, we weren't sure how to deal with that in light of your question, so we reworked the rule to simply say "as provided by the Department." Please let us know if you have any questions, concerns, or recommendations about that approach.
