In (a)(1), line 8, please insert a comma after "students" and before "defined as"

In (a)(2), line 11, please insert a comma after "employees" before "defined as"

On line 13, please insert a comma after "seeking"

In (a)(4), line 17, please insert a comma after "Interns"

Also on line 17, please delete the comma after "hours" and on line 18, insert a comma after "enrolled" to mirror the language in (a)(5). Thus, "... regardless of the number of credit hours enrolled, work to gain..."

On line 18, do you need "short" here when you specify that this will not exceed three months?

In (a)(5), line 20, please insert a comma after "Externs"

Also on line 20, please delete the comma after "hours" And on line 21, insert a comma after "enrolled"

On line 22, consider replacing "by" with "through"

In (b), line 23, please capitalize "State" if you mean NC.

In (c), line 25, what are "temporaries"? Do you mean "temporary appointments"?

Also on line 25, please capitalize "State" if you mean NC.
