Reason for Proposed Temporary Action: G.S. 150B-21.1(a)(7) b. and c. As a result of a cold stun event and in accordance with the North Carolina Spotted Sea Trout Fishery Management Plan, the N.C. Division of Marine Fisheries (NCDMF) issued a proclamation closing the recreational and commercial harvest of Spotted Sea Trout in joint and coastal fishing waters until June 15, 2025. To alleviate angler confusion, the proposed amendments will close Spotted Sea Trout harvest until June 15, 2025, in waters within NCWRC's jurisdiction (Inland Fishing Waters and hook-and-line in Joint Fishing Waters) to be consistent with the NCDMF closure.

SUBCHAPTER 10C - INLAND FISHING REGULATIONS

SECTION .0300 - GAME FISH IN INLAND FISHING WATERS

15A NCAC 10C .0325 SEA TROUT

(a) The daily creel limit for sea trout (spotted or speckled) is four fish.

(b) The minimum size limit is 14 inches.

(c) There is no closed season.

(a) Sea trout (spotted or speckled) shall not be taken or possessed. (b) The temporary amendment shall expire on June 15, 2025.
