Needs to add: "PARTF grants are awarded to grantees for projects that are for the sole purpose of providing local park and recreation opportunities to the public, THAT ARE NOT CURRENTLY BEING PROVIDED" section (a) (2) (b) is too broad. limitations need to be placed on these 'non-recreational' costs not to exceed 5% of the grant Section (b) (3) is so broad as to open the door for corruption of the grant process. All costs listed need too be followed or proceeded by the word 'reasonable'. All costs eligible need to be paid to 3-rd party non-governmental units not to applicants. Item (c) needs to be deleted in whole. The cost of the grant writing should never be a reimbursable item.
