Dear Ms. Mackenzie:

Rules promulgated by the North Carolina State Lottery Commission are required to be published in the North Carolina Administrative Code.¹ Although the State Lottery Commission is exempt from the standard rulemaking process, G.S. 150B-21.21(b) requires that "...exempt agencies must submit a rule to the Codifier of Rules within 30 days after adopting the rule."

The submission forms for the filing submitted today show these rules were adopted on December 13, 2023, meaning these rules were filed for publication in the Code outside the 30-day timeframe set in statute. The filing does not point to any statutory authority allowing me to enter these rules into the Code outside the 30-day mandate. Absent such authority, I will not be able to process this filing.
