- 2 made complete within 30 days of receipt, the incomplete petitions will be returned to the person from whom the

- 4 (c) Petition Fee. A non-refundable petition fee of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) shall accompany each petition. This fee
- 5 may be paid by certified bank check or money order made payable to the North Carolina Social Work Certification
- 6 and Licensure Board. Cash shall not be accepted.
- 7 (d) Delegation of Authority for Predetermination. The Board delegates authority for rendering predeterminations
- 8 under this Rule to a committee of the Board that is tasked with reviewing disciplinary matters. matters, the members
- 9 of which shall be determined by the Board Chair or their designee.
