At its meeting this morning, the Rules Review Commission objected to the above-captioned temporary Rule in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.1(b).

The Rules Review Commission objected to 21 NCAC 18B .0308 for lack of statutory authority. Specifically, the Commission found that the State Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors did not have authority under G.S. 87-1.1 to limit the percentage of plumbing, heating, or fire sprinkler contracting work in any bid submitted pursuant to that statute.
