The Department's original LPO rules included two sunset dates. By a temporary rule that was effective on July 1, 2020, the sunset dates of the Local Public Offering ("LPO") Crowdfunding "Sunset Rule" were extended. This temporary rule assisted NC small businesses that were facing economic uncertainty due to the pandemic.

To continue the accessibility of responsible intrastate crowdfunding, the Secretary of State proposed, and has now adopted, this permanent amendment to the Sunset Rule, 18 NCAC 06A .2120. To continue the accessibility of responsible intrastate crowdfunding, the rule will (1) extend the sunset provisions to accept new Form NCE – LPO or other filings related to a new LPO by five years, and (2) extend the expiration of the LPO rules in Section .2100 by five years.

The Secretary of State is adopting the temporary rule, verbatim, as a permanent rule.

9.B. Explanation:

On March 10, 2020, the Governor of North Carolina, by issuing Executive Order No. 116, declared a state of emergency to coordinate a response and enact protective measures to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. COVID-19 is respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death. COVID-19, previously unidentified in humans, spreads easily from person to person. Once an outbreak of COVID-19 begins, it is difficult to contain. The World Health Organization, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, and the United States Department of Health and Human Services have declared COVID-19 a public health threat and emergency. The search for potential treatments for COVID-19 has caused shortages and threatens to cause further shortages in certain drugs. On March 24, 2020, the North Carolina State Health Director requested that the Medical Board, the Board of Nursing and the Board of Pharmacy adopt the COVID-19 Drug Preservation Rule in order to alleviate shortages and ensure that these drugs are available to patients who need them. This rule was adopted as an emergency and then a temporary rule. The State Health Director requested that the rule be adopted as a permanent rule because the state of emergency and corresponding potential drug shortages now may potentially extend beyond the expiration of the temporary rule. The Board intends to repeal the rule upon the conclusion of the state of emergency. The State Health Director determined that the State is unlikely to suffer future shortages of two of the drugs previously listed in the temporary and emergency rule. Those drugs were removed from the rule, while the others remain.
