> Re: N.C. Department of Commerce Periodic Review of Existing Rules Request for Extension of Time 26 NCAC 05 .0204

Mr. Dunklin:

I am writing to you pursuant to 26 NCAC 05 .0204(a) to request an extension of time within which to file the Periodic Review and Expiration of Existing Rules Report for Submission to the Rules Review Commission form for the rules contained in Title 4, Chapter 1 of the N.C. Administrative Code, entitled Departmental Rules.

The N.C. Department of Commerce is a large agency divided into various divisions. Historically, the Department has been staffed with four (4) attorneys – two (2) in-house attorneys and two (2) attorneys from the N.C. Attorney General's Office on contract. Recently, the Department has undergone a reorganization that has resulted in the reduction of our attorney staff to two (2) attorneys – both in-house. As a result, our attorneys have been overwhelmed with work. As a result, their review of the administrative rules contained in 04 NCAC Chapter 01 has been delayed.

I know that the periodic review of existing rules is an important and necessary process, and I have asked my staff to make this a priority. At this time, we anticipate completing Step 1 of the review process outlined in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 150B-21.3A(c) by the end of next week, such that we can have it up on our website, and send it to the N.C. Office of Administrative Hearings – Rules Division for positing on its website, shortly. However, based upon this timeline, we will not be able to meet the deadline set forth in 26 NCAC 05 .0211 for submitting the report to the Rules Review Commission for consideration at the March 2016 meeting.
