In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following technical changes be made:

(a) and (b) appear to repeat each other with (b) providing an additional requirement. Did you intend to delete (a)? If not, please make the difference between the two more clear.

In (c), delete ".0407" in "under this Rule .0407," so that it just reads "this Rule," The formatting would be "this Rule .0407, Rule,"

In (c), who is to do these things? The officer? Please rewrite (c) to say who will do what. If the officer is responsible for these things, a suggestion would be something like:

(b) (c) In order for an officer to be certified under this Rule .0407, there must be: he or she shall:

- (1) **compliance** <u>comply</u> with the Report of Appointment form requirement of Rule .0403 of this Section;
- (2) submitted_submit to the Division, a copy of the Oath of Office for applicants requesting certification as a deputy sheriff; and

(3) submitted submit to the Division verification that the applicant meets the requirement of this Rule .0407(a)(2).

Depending on what you decide to do with (a), please double check (c)(3). Even if you intended to delete it, I think this is fine, but you would need to change your (b) back to (a) and your (c) back to (b).
