7. Why is adherence to notice and hearing requirements contrary to the public interest and the immediate adoption of the				
rule is required?  The North Carolina Manufactured and Modular Homebuilders Association Registered Housing Specialist class and the Manufactured Housing Salesperson's test have been postponed until 90 days after the resumption of the Residential Housing Specialist class conducted by the North Carolina Manufactured and Modular Homebuilders Association. Without passing the Manufactured Housing Salesperson's test the salesperson may no longer engage in business as a manufactured housing salesperson.				
When the Board initially adopted its emergency rule and submitted the proposed temporary rule for publication on the OAH website, it was based upon conditions set forth in an early "Stay at Home Order" issued by the Governor. However, as the situation progresses, that order was amended by other Executive Orders. The Board therefore changed the language that was initially proposed as the temporary rule based upon the changing the circumstances.				
It is necessary for the Board to adopt this Rule immediately in order to ensure that the regulated public is allowed to be employed under temporary licensure until the avenues to pursue permanent licensure are re-opened.

1 11 NCAC 08 .0913 is adopted under temporary procedures with changes as follows: 2 3 11 NCAC 08.0913 EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY LICENSE FOR MANUFACTURED HOUSING 4 SALESPERSON 5 (a) A temporary manufactured housing salesperson's license issued by the North Carolina Manufactured Housing 6 Board [which] that would otherwise expire 90 days after issuance pursuant to 11 NCAC 08 .0911(b) [after March 1, 7 2020 shall not expire until 60 days after the Covid 19 "Stay at Home" order is rescinded by the Governor of North 8 Carolina. shall not expire until 90 days after the resumption of the Residential Housing Specialist class conducted 9 by the North Carolina Manufactured and Modular Homebuilders Association. The applicant shall take the 10 Manufactured Salesperson's License exam in accordance with 11 NCAC 08.0911(a) [at one of the next two test dates scheduled by the North Carolina Manufactured Housing Board after the Covid 19 "Stay at Home" order is rescinded 11 by the Governor of North Carolina.] within the 90-day period after the resumption of the class. 12 13 (b) In the event an applicant [who has been affected by the Covid 19 extension fails to take the exam or] whose 14 temporary license has been extended by this Rule fails to attain a passing grade of 70 percent of a possible 100 percent [at one of the next two scheduled dates after the order has been rescinded,] within the 90-day period in Paragraph (a) 15 of this Rule, the temporary salesperson's license shall expire. 16 17 18 Authority G.S. 143-143.10(b)(1); 143-143.10(b)(4); 143-143.11; History Note: 19 Emergency Adoption Eff.
