The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following technical changes be made:

On the Submission for Permanent Rule form, Box 3, please show that this is an amendment, not a readoption.

In the Introductory Statement, line 1, please reflect that is an amendment.

Throughout this Rule, lines 7 through 15, as well as the History Note on line 17, remove the highlighting. Highlighting is used to show changes made after publication; you published all of these changes in the Register. Please do highlight any changes made to the Rule text in response to this Request for Technical Changes unless told otherwise.

In (a)(2), line 6, delete the "or" after "deductible;"

On line 10, please show that (c) is being deleted and replace it with (b). As this was published correctly in the Register, do not show it as a change; simply do it. Please note the same for changing former (c) to (b) on line 10.

On line 10, you published "state" lowercase. Please show the change to "State" by removing the underlining from "state" and striking, highlighting, and bracketing the term and then inserting "State" by underlining and highlighting it.

*In (b)(1), what are these manuals?* 

In (b)(2), line 12, please insert a comma after "burned" And I am only asking – is the only way that the cards can be defaced such that they will be replaced?

In (b)(3), line 13, please capitalize "State" if you mean "NC" and insert a hyphen in the term "Stateissued"

Consider replacing the "and" at the end of line 13 with an "or"

In the History Note, line 22, please reflect that this is an amendment rather than a readoption.

Also in the History Note, line 17, please simply insert a semicolon after "4D.2" Do not show it as a change; just do it.
