## **REQUEST FOR TECHNICAL CHANGE**

The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may call our office to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following technical changes be made:

I understand that pursuant to G.S. 150B-1(d)(26)(a), the fees for the State Fair are exempt from rulemaking and that they must be posted on the website. So, why not include that website here? You could add it to (a), line 4, "All persons... pay the established admission fee listed on [url]..."

On line 4, consider replacing "must" with "shall"

On line 5, what are "worker's permits" and "special promotion"?

Overall, why do you need the language on lines 5-7? What is it regulating?

Assuming you need to retain it:

On line 5, I suggest you delete the comma after "One-time-only"

On line 6, who will issue this? Under what circumstances? Do you mean "shall"?

Why is "Fair" capitalized on line 6 but not on line 7?

Also on line 7, what is a "specific purpose relative to the operation"?

On lines 13-14, was this language removed due to public comment?

In (b), line 15, what is a "pass-out system"? Is this the name for the readmittance system?

On line 16, how is a vehicle stamped for readmittance?

In the History Note, line 35, delete the date of "October 1, 2019" and retain it only on Page 2, line 1.
