The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following technical changes be made:

In (c), line 8, what does "conditioning" mean? (I note the term is also in the name of the Rule, but as the name is not within RRC purview, I am asking specifically regarding this rule text.)

In (c)(3), the way I am reading this is that the vendor will be allowed to determine the maximum number of times each individual can take the exam. Is the intent to grant this discretion without any Board guidance to the vendor?

2 3 21 NCAC 08F .0105 **CONDITIONING REQUIREMENTS** 4 (a) Passing Grades. A candidate shall pass all sections of the examination with a grade of 75 or higher on each section. 5 (b) Military Service.
