Such reports must be filed in the office of the Board not later than the 10th day of the calendar month which immediately follows the completion of each one month period of resident traineeship. Failure 15 to submit such reports when due shall be sufficient cause for suspension or revocation of the certificate of resident 16 17 traineeship. 18 (1)The trainee's name and signature; 19 The month during which the work was performed; (2)20 (3) The number of hours worked during [the preceding] that month; 21 The name and address of the funeral establishment where the resident trainee is working: (4) 22 <u>A description of the work performed during [the preceding</u>] that month; (5) 23 (6) The name, license number, and notarized signature of the trainee's supervisor; and 24 The name, license number, and notarized signature of the licensed manager of the funeral (7)25 establishment where the resident trainee is working. 26 (b) By signing the work report, the trainee's supervisor shall certify that the data contained in the report is correct. 27 Neither the trainee nor the trainee's supervisor shall be permitted to amend or revise the work report after it is 28 submitted to the Board. The Board shall not accept incomplete work reports and a trainee who fails to submit a complete work report by the due date [on which it is due] shall be subject to the provisions of Paragraph (c) of this 29 30 Rule. 31 (c) A late fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be assessed against the trainee for each work report that is submitted to the Board after the due date. [date on which it is due. Additionally, following] Following a trainee's first failure 32 33 to timely submit a work report, the Board shall issue the trainee a letter that cautions against future non-compliance 34 with this Rule. Following a trainee's second failure to timely submit a work report, the work set forth in the second 35 untimely work report shall not be credited toward the certification of the trainee's resident traineeship. Following a trainee's third failure to timely submit a work report, the Board shall revoke the trainee's resident traineeship. 36
