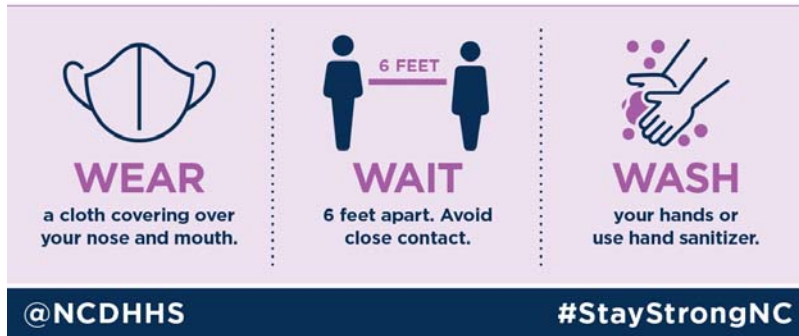

Hi Denise,

I hope you're doing well! Attached are SHRC's requests for technical changes. Your responses and revised rules are due by Friday, October 9.

While you are reviewing, please note the following question in 25 NCAC 01E .1603: *In (b)(2), where is your statutory authority to limit alternative leave for literacy programs to 45 hours? See G.S. 126-4(5b).* The 45 hour limit was proposed by SHRC in 2015 and RRC objected to the language. The objection letter and staff opinion from 2015 are attached. Since RRC has objected to this language in the past, please understand I will have to issue a staff opinion for the same reason if this issue is not resolved in technical changes. Please let me know if you have any questions.
