The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following technical changes be made:

In (a)(2), please delete or define "successful"

In (d), rather than "with the physical presence of a supervising North Carolina licensed dentist", please consider saying "under the direct supervision of a North Carolina licensed dentist." I make this suggestion since "direct supervision" is 90-221, as amended by S.L. 2021-95.

Please retype the rule accordingly and resubmit it to our office at 1711 New Hope Church Road, Raleigh, North Carolina 27609.

1 21 NCAC 16G .0109 is adopted <u>with changes</u> under temporary procedures as follows:

3 21 NCAC 16G .0109 DENTAL HYGIENIST CERTIFICATION ТО ADMINISTER LOCAL 4 **ANESTHETICS** 5 (a) To apply for certification to administer local anesthetics by block or infiltration techniques: 6 (1)a dental hygienist holding a valid dental hygiene license issued by the Board on or after October 1, 7 2021, shall submit to the Board a certificate of completion from a dental hygiene program meeting 8 the requirements set out in G.S. 90-225.2; and or

- 9 (2) a dental hygienist licensed in North Carolina or any other state or territory who has been practicing 10 dental hygiene for the two year period set out in G.S. 90-225.3(a)(2) shall submit to the Board: 11 Board evidence of completion of a course meeting the requirements of G.S. 90-225(a)(3), including 12 a notarized letter from a licensed dentist instructor stating the applicant's successful completion of 13 the required injections in a course.
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 (A) evidence of successful completion of a course meeting the requirements of G.S. 90

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 225.3(a)(3)(a) (c); or
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 (B) evidence of successful completion of a course meeting the requirements of G.S. 90

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 225.3(a)(3)(a) and (b), and a notarized letter from a North Carolina licensed dentist stating

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 the applicant's experience and competency in satisfaction of G.S. 90-225(a)(3)(c).

(b) The requirements set out in Paragraph (a) of this Rule are in addition to any other applicable requirements set outin this Chapter for the issuance or renewal of a dental hygiene license.

(c) As a condition to renew a certificate to administer local anesthetics, each dental hygienist shall complete two clock
 hours of continuing education each calendar year in satisfaction of the requirements of G.S. 90-225.3(c), which may

23 be among those chosen to satisfy the requirements set out in 21 NCAC 16I .0201(a).

(d) A dental hygienist certified in accordance with this Rule shall conduct administration of local anesthetics only
 with the physical presence of a supervising North Carolina licensed dentist.
