Dear Rules Review Commission,

The North Carolina Auctioneer Licensing Board's readoption date was scheduled at the Rules Review Commission's June 2017 meeting for 47 rules. This is every Rule the Board currently has in the Code, as the Board decided to designate every rule as "necessary with substantive public interest" during the Periodic Review and Expiration of Existing Rules Process in G.S. 150B-21.3A. The Board and Rules Review Commission agreed to a readoption date of February 28, 2019, which was only 18 months away, because the Board knew it would take this work seriously and devote resources to the project.

The Board worked diligently on the readoption project, as the staff reached out to its regulated public and interested parties to get feedback and make proposed changes. After hearing from the interested parties and making some changes based upon that feedback, Board staff contacted RRC staff to ask for a pre-review. RRC staff provided extensive notes. While the Board appreciated the work of RRC staff, it had not anticipated the amount and depth of changes and questions presented in the pre-review.

The Board is committed to meeting its readoption deadline, but also committed to making changes during the readoption process to ensure that its rules are within its authority, are clear, and useful to the Board and its regulated public. In order to do so, the Board will need additional time to incorporate the notes from RRC counsel. In addition, the Board would like an opportunity to follow up informally with the stakeholders that were initially involved so that they

will be aware of the reason for some of the proposed changes before publication. Therefore, the Board respectfully requests an extension of the readoption date to February 29, 2020.
