Inspection fee increases are necessary to make market-based staff salaries adequate to recruit and retain technical staff as EAD inspector salaries have fallen behind regionally and are significantly lower than private sector salaries. This is especially true in relation to the expanded roles of EAD inspectors who must inspect elevators, escalators, wind turbine elevators, construction lifts, handicap lifts, and personnel hoists. The EAD inspectors perform a vital role in ensuring that the safety and welfare of the public is well-guarded. NCDOL has determined that specific expertise is needed for individuals to perform inspections and to maintain ongoing educational standards for new elevator designs and new amusement device designs, which are becoming more computer driven rather than purely mechanical. The annual inspection of elevators and other devices takes place on a rolling basis; other inspections are performed upon installation or alteration. *Note: domestic elevators are not inspected pursuant to the NC Elevator Safety Act.
