

21 NCAC 58A .0305 is adopted under temporary procedures with changes as follows:

21 NCAC 58A .0305 PETITION FOR PREDETERMINATION

(a) An individual who wishes to file a petition for a predetermination of whether the individual's criminal history will likely disqualify the individual from obtaining a real estate license shall submit a petition on the Commission's website.

(b) The petition shall include the petitioner's:

- (1) legal name;
- (2) mailing, physical, and email addresses;
- (3) social security number;
- (4) date of birth;
- (5) telephone number;
- (6) places of residence for the past seven years;
- (7) employment history during the last three years or since the date of the crime was committed;
petitioner's last criminal conviction, whichever is greater;
- (8) criminal record report prepared by the Commission's approved independent vendor pursuant to G.S.
93B-8.1 no more than 60 days prior to the date of petition;
- (9) written statement describing the circumstances surrounding the commission of the crime(s);
- (10) written statement of any rehabilitation efforts, if applicable;
- (11) rehabilitative drug or alcohol treatments, if applicable;
- (12) Certificate of Relief granted pursuant to G.S. 15A-173.2, if applicable;
- (13) affidavits or other written documents, including character references, that the petitioner intends to
submit for review; references;
- (14) certification; certification that the information is true and accurate; and
- (15) signature.

(c) The fee for a petition for predetermination shall be forty-five dollars (\$45.00).
