Articles to be sanitized must be placed on racks, or other 7 devices provided therein so that a minimum space of six inches is left around each item being sanitized, and between the 8 item and the walls, floor, ceiling, and other items. Loose materials to be sanitized must be placed on tiers or slats, or in 9 other arrangements that permit an even distribution of heat throughout the material. A thermometer that has been 10 checked for accuracy within one degree F. must be placed within the chamber at a point where it can be easily read at all 11 times through a window for that purpose. (b) In the washing process, the bedding is shall be boiled for two hours and washed with an approved a soap or 12 detergent.
