- (b) The applicant's score on the prequalification course set forth in Subparagraph (a)(3) of this Rule is valid for 180 days

- 20 (c) In lieu of completing the training course set forth in Subparagraph (a)(4) of this Rule, an applicant may submit to the
- 21 Board a current Criminal Justice Specialized Law Enforcement Firearms Instructor Certificate from the North Carolina

- 23 (d) In lieu of Subparagraphs (a)(2) and (4) of this Rule, an applicant may establish to the Board's satisfaction a military
- occupational specialty and two years of verifiable experience within the past five years in the U.S. Armed Forces as afirearms instructor.
