

Counsel Note

Your agency submitted a rule for certification for publication pursuant to G.S. 150B-19.1. The Commission has not met and has not made a decision regarding this request.

In reviewing the rule submitted by your agency for certification, Counsel has noted the following, and recommends changing the rule as set forth below.

These are not required changes for approval pursuant to G.S. 150B-19.1. Do not submit a rewritten rule to address the requests set forth below. This is intended to assist you in preparing the rules for publication in the N.C. Register. Therefore, if you make these changes, please format them as required by 26 NCAC Subchapter 02C.

Rule Citation: 12 NCAC 09G .0412

Agency: Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission

Line 5, replace “must” with “shall”

Line 11, replace “is to” with ”shall”

Lines 11 thru 12, what the basic curriculum training courses? Why is that information not set forth in this Rule? Is there another rule that contains the information and could be referenced?

1 12 NCAC 09G .0412 is proposed for amendment as follows:

2 12 NCAC 09G .0412 BASIC TRAINING FOR PROBATION/PAROLE OFFICERS

3 (a) The basic training course for probation/parole officers shall consist of at least ~~160~~ 207 hours of instruction, as
4 approved by the Commission, designed to provide the trainee with the skills and knowledge to perform those tasks
5 essential to function as a probation/parole officer. The instructional components of this course must be listed in the
6 "Basic Probation/Parole Officer Training Manual," and shall include firearms training; administrative matters, review and
7 testing; controls, restraints, and defensive techniques; court processes; case processing and management; arrest
8 procedures; basic life support; employee wellness; professional ethics; personal and professional conduct; and
9 contemporary correctional theory.

10 (b) The "Basic Probation/Parole Officer Training Manual" as published by the North Carolina Department of ~~Correction~~
11 Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction is to be applied as the basic curriculum for delivery of probation/parole
